## Summary of Five Possible Directions

During the summer and fall of 2022, the Line 3 IAMC Committee members built upon the renewal recommendations and explored what the future of the committee could look like.

They generated 5 possible directions:

- 1) Become a stable entity throughout the lifespan of Line 3, from development through to operations and eventual decommissioning
- Enhance engagement and relationships among Métis and First Nation leaders and community members and decision-makers within the Government of Canada, including NRCan, other related ministries, and the CER
- 3) Expand the Line 3 IAMC Indigenous Monitoring opportunities through meaningful capacity development and employment opportunities
- 4) Explore expanding the Line 3 IAMC scope to include all CER-regulated projects in the Line 3 corridor, as well as decision-making authorities
- 5) Co-develop and incorporate an impact evaluation and knowledge translation process and strategy into the Line 3 IAMC's work
